

PUBLIC NOTICE

PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE, (MAIN STREET, PEMBROKE), (FREEDOM OF PEMBROKE PARADE) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION) ORDER 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that the Pembrokeshire County Council has made the following Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the prevention of obstruction etc.

WHEREAS during certain hours on Saturday 15th September 2018, due to a Freedom of Pembroke parade taking place, Main Street, Pembroke, from its junction with Northgate Street, east to a point near St Michaels Square will be thronged and liable to be obstructed.

Pembrokeshire County Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 **DO HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT** that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said Street on the said day, the following regulations shall be observed:-

1. Subject to those provisions contained in article 2 of this Order, Main Street, Pembroke shall be closed to all vehicular traffic on **Saturday 15th September 2018 between 10.00hrs and 12.00hrs** whilst the parade takes place on or adjacent to the public highway.
2. Nothing in article 1 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used by the emergency services or anything done with the permission or under the direction of a Police Officer or Traffic Management Operative.
3. Drivers of vehicles approaching Main Street from Mill Bridge and wishing to proceed in an easterly direction along Main Street to East End Square shall be diverted via Castle Terrace, Westgate Hill, Common Road, Orange Way and Well Hill.
4. Drivers of vehicles approaching Westgate Hill from Monkton Bridge and wishing to proceed in an easterly direction along Main Street to East End Square shall be diverted via Common Road, Orange Way and Well Hill.

Mae Cyngor Sir Penfro, yn unol â'r pwerau a gyflwynir gan Adran 21 o'r Ddeddf Cyfrifoldebau Heddluoedd Trefol 1847, **GAN HYNNY YN GORCHYMYN A CHYFARWYDDO** er mwyn atal rhwystrau yn y Stryd dan sylw ar y dyddiad dan sylw, bydd y rheoliadau canlynol yn cael eu dilyn:-

1. Yn ddarostyngedig i'r amodau rheiny sydd yn erthygl 2 o'r Gorchymyn hwn, bydd Stryd Fawr, Penfro ar gau i'r holl draffig cerbydol ar **ddydd Sadwrn 15 Medi 2018 rhwng 10.00yb a 12.00yh** tra bod yr orymdaith yn cymryd lle ar neu'n agos i'r briffordd gyhoeddus.
2. Ni fydd unrhyw amod o fewn erthygl 1 o'r Gorchymyn yn cael ei osod ar unrhyw gerbyd a ddefnyddir gan y gwasanaethau argyfwng neu ar unrhyw beth a wneir gyda chaniatâd neu dan gyfarwyddyd Swyddog Heddlu neu Weithiwr Rheoli Traffic.
3. Bydd gyrwyr sy'n teithio tuag at y Stryd Fawr o gyfeiriad Pont y Felin ac yn dymuno parhau mewn cyfeiriad dwyreiniol ar hyd y Stryd Fawr i Sgwar East End yn cael eu cyfeirio trwy Castle Terrace, Westgate Hill, Ffordd Common, Orange Way a Well Hill.
4. Bydd gyrwyr sy'n teithio tuag at Westgate Hill o Bont Monkton ac yn dymuno parhau mewn cyfeiriad dwyreiniol ar hyd y Stryd Fawr i Sgwar East End yn cael eu cyfeirio trwy Ffordd Common, Orange Way a Well Hill.
